

BUILDING FACILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 26, 2011

The committee met at 7pm at the High School. We broke down into our small groups to work on the town hall meeting presentations.

Chris presented the Taxpayer Feedback Worksheet he was working on and we went through the various sections. Chris addressed several questions that had been raised in past meetings:

1. The retro fit at the power plant will not affect assessed values-this is great news.
2. FEMA storm shelters cannot be used as gyms as the capacity would not be supported by our low population. To receive aid based on the populations of our area, shelters would need to have a capacity of around 600 people and the cost per shelter would be approximately \$250,000.

We reviewed the taxpayer worksheet by each question and made suggestions for improvement. Several questions were raised during this discussion:

1. Who owns the bus barn in LaCygne? The school district.
2. Has the community raised concerns about handicap accommodations at the football stadium? No

We moved to the agenda of the first town hall meeting. Discussion was heard regarding the use of the read and green dots-pros and cons, if the written worksheet would be tallied as well as the dots and what we were going to use the information for once it is compiled.

Chris reported that 2600 flyers had been sent and School reach messages had been sent as well as texts. Members of the committee will call and personally invite/ remind city mayors and councils of each meeting. The meetings will be:
