High Achievement Unit Outcomes: Dramatic Elements

KS OUTCOME 1: Define and describe the dramatic elements of Drama/Theatre

Components:

- Listen and respond to stories
- Identify subjects of stories.

High Achievement Unit Outcomes: Self-Awareness

KS OUTCOME 2: Develop and communicate an awareness of self and society through Drama/Theatre

Components:

- Examine and respond to sensory and emotional experiences.
- Use language, movement, and/or voice for personal exploration as a means of self-expression.

High Achievement Unit Outcomes: Dramatic Performance

KS OUTCOME 3: Create Drama/Theatre

Components:

- Participate in dramatic play.
- Identify and assume roles through imitation.

High Achievement Unit Outcomes: Dramatic Appreciation

KS OUTCOME 4: Develop the skills for appreciation and evaluation of Drama/Theatre

Components:

- Practice appropriate audience behaviors by viewing drama/theatre events.
- Recognize and discuss real life from fictional situations in drama/theatre events.
